Our recommendations ·····

Continued funding for homelessness prevention including rapid re-housing, support for the 'Housing First' approach and accelerating the availability of affordable homes Use homelessness statistics to **target prevention** work where it is most needed

Support people struggling financially in their tenancies beyond the Covid-19 halt on evictions Continue to build on partnerships between local authorities and third sector

Involve people who have experience of homelessness and front-line workers in the formation of policy
