Households



In 2023, there were just under **300,000** households in Glasgow. That's a **10% increase** since 2001.

2018 data show:



44% were single adult households.



7% were single adult and children.



27% were two adults households.



73% of dwellings in Glasgow are flats.

11% are terraced houses.

4% are detached dwellings.

24%

of dwellings are thought to be in need of urgent repair (2017-2019).
