Transport links:

Railway: The Bridgeton Cross station is directly adjacent to the Olympia Building, 4 trains per hour each way to Glasgow Argyle St (3 min); Glasgow Central Station (5 min); SECC (10 min)

Bus: Excellent bus routes outside the rail station with six services per hour linking to the city centre, many more routes operate in the surrounding streets.
